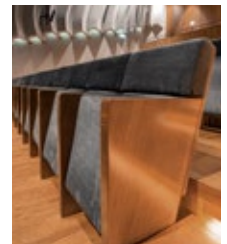




PERFECT HARMONY OF FORMS

To meet the expectations of even the most demanding music lovers, the Forum Seating brand has introduced a unique armchair into the market: Pablo. It is a combination of classic elegance, perfect materials and innovative constructional solutions. The armchairs belonging to this line have been assembled in the chamber hall of the Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestra, for example.

Every element of the Pablo armchair highlights its unusual character. The backrest has an exceptional cubic form and is made of solid plywood, which is made of deciduous wood.

The backrest has been smoothly combined with the armchair legs, which makes the form even more harmonious. The interior acquires a geometrical look, also thanks to wide headrests, which create lines when touching each other. The armchair legs can be made of many plywood layers connected horizontally (called birch up). It is a very laborious method, but it gives the product an even more spectacular look. In addition, the specially designed hinge minimises the distance between the seat and the armchair legs. Moreover, all the assembly elements have been hidden, which makes the armchair look even more perfect.

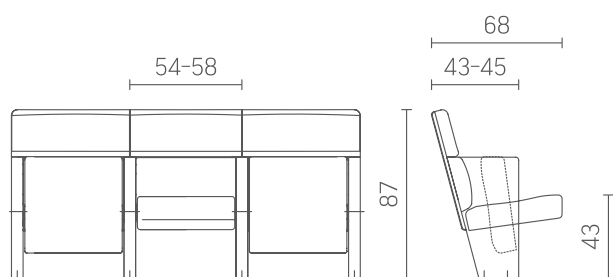
The seat structure is made of a metal carcass embedded in deformation-resistant polyurethane foam. The armchairs have been equipped with a double backrest cushion and a foam seat, which provide users with excellent comfort, even during concerts or plays that last several hours. The armchairs have been also equipped with a special mechanism that ensures their quiet folding.

Thanks to its structure and innovative solutions, the Pablo armchair has excellent acoustic and aesthetic properties. It can be found in the chamber hall of the Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestra and in the Academy of Music in Katowice, where it looks impressive.

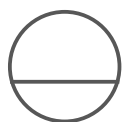

CHARACTERISTIC FEATURES AND AVAILABLE OPTIONS:

- The back part of the backrest and the armchair legs are made of plywood, which is made of deciduous wood.
- The assembly elements have been hidden in the armchair structure.
- Both the seat and backrest are made of deformation-resistant polyurethane foam.
- The armchair is equipped with a quiet folding mechanism.
- Some armchairs can be fixed as cantilever models, which means they can be removed easily. This is exceptionally useful and allows for different arrangements of the hall (e.g. when there is a need to make some room for camera operators).

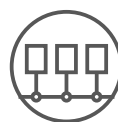
